Chamila Cooray



Chamila is a Fellow Member of CA Sri Lanka and has served the Council of the Institute since 2020.

As the Chairperson of the Student Training and Skills Development Committee, she pioneered the implementation of the Virtual Skills Development Programme for the first time expediting the membership awarding process during the pandemic. She guided the compilation of the Skill Assessment Report to improve the students' professional skills, revamped the viva-voce process / interim student assessment.

As the Chairperson of the Annual Report Award Revamp Task Force, she was able to introduce an insightful concept for the Awards, creating a turning point in the 56 years long history of this competition. As the Alternate Chairperson of the Annual Report Awards 2021, she worked on the organisational responses towards pandemic. As the Alternate Chairperson of the Task Force for Simplification of Laws & Regulations, she worked extensively on evaluation of the Exchange Control Act, BOI & other related regulations on IT / BPM industry.

Since 2008 she has been playing a dynamic role working in different committees. She steered the mentoring programme for young CAs and chaired the introduction of CPD monitoring mechanism. Her technical and industry expertise enabled to provide valuable input for review of curriculum and study packs. She served as a member of the Industry Experts and CSR Marking Panel of CA Annual Report Awards almost a decade and in the panel of SAFA Awards for over 5 years.

Chamila started her career at KPMG and counts over 20 years of experience in the entire spectrum of Finance & Accounting (F&A) in diverse industries. She served as the Director / Head of Technical of CA Sri Lanka and spearheaded the IFRS convergence project. She became the first Sri Lankan CA to receive a scholarship from CPA Australia and AusAids to follow a comprehensive study programme in Australia.
